### Fees:

The declaration fee is \$550 and is due on Tuesday, December 15.

The entry fee will be based on the number of teams that declare to participate in the championship.

Note: A minimum of eight teams must declare for the championship to be held.

## **Declaration Procedures:**

All entries and boating forms must be completed online at www.RegattaCentral.com.

#### **No-Show Policy:**

If an institution enters the meet by submitting an entry form and subsequently fails to compete in the championship, the institution shall forfeit the entry fee, and will be subject to an additional \$500 penalty. These must be paid prior to admittance to any future ECAC Championship event.

#### **Hotel Accommodations:**

Institutions are responsible for making their own hotel accommodations. A room block has not been secured by the ECAC.

#### Awards:

Medals will be presented to the student-athletes of the top three finishing crews in each event. Awards will be presented to the first place crew in each event. An overall point trophy will be award to the first place team.
